ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. **Age Criteria** : The players shall be under 19 years of age group as on 31/12/2022 i.e. For under 19 years: born on or after 01.01.2004.
2. A junior player can be permitted to play in senior age group, and then the participation in the original group will be forfeited i.e. one player can't be the part of more than one team.
3. Each participant must carry identity card with photograph duly signed by the head of the institution, valid for the current year. Participants must be in the condition to present the same whenever it is asked by the competent authority.
4. Only bonafide students shall be eligible to participate in the National tournament. Fielding any non bonafide student shall lead to the disqualification of the team.
5. The participating school's Principal should sign the Eligibility Proforma.
6. The form should not bear unauthorized or over writings, as the organizing school would not treat it as valid.
7. Incomplete Proforma in any respect will not be entertained.
8. All the supporting papers verifying the age of the players etc. in original shall be carried personally by the Team Manager/ Coach while reporting for the participation. Students studying in class IX and above must provide CBSE registration number /card. Students studying in class XI & XII must carry class X mark sheet with photo issued by the Board. If any player of the team is a student of class VI to VIII, the team must submit a photocopy of Birth Certificate and Adhaar Card.
9. The player's right to participate forfeits if fails to produce the papers supporting the eligibility in original on demand.
10. Please ensure that the names of the participants are written legibly without spelling mistakes to facilitate proper certification.
11. The decision of the referee on all technical aspects will be final.
12. **PROTEST**- Protest against the decision of official on a point of rule and protest of any other nature in connection with the game shall be in writing and must reach to the Organizing Secretary within an hour of the declaration of the result, duly accompanied with a fee receipt of Rs.1000/- (Rupees one thousand only) to school account office. The Jury of Appeal will consider such a protest.
13. The school will not be responsible for any item/s lost by participants during their stay. It should be ensured that the costly items are kept under lock and key. It will be the responsibility of the team managers to take care of the sick or injured player/s of their team. However, the sick students and officials may report to our school medical in-charge for First Aid.
14. As per the rules of CBSE Sports Committee, if a school after sending the entry wishes to withdraw its team from the tournament, it shall be given in a written notice of its intention to do so to the organizing secretary. School with drawing without informing to the organizing school, will be penalized with a penalty of Rs. 1000/-.

15. Each contingent must bring its school flag as it would be required for the March past at the inaugural ceremony.
16. All the teams are requested to bring with them their school sports uniform to participate in the inaugural March past.
18. Entries: It is the responsibility of schools to fill in all the ANNEXURES and submit in time to the Host school. Once the details are received, no change will be permitted.
19. Details and Proforma for entry are available on CBSE website. Kindly go through the details carefully before filling up the Proforma.
20. On the spot entry will not be entertained in any condition.
21. Each team must submit Annexure - I, II & III through email by 26th December 2022 and Annexure IV & V at the time of reporting.

BOARDING AND LODGING

1. Separate accommodation arrangement for boys & girls team will be made. The participants have to bring air pillows while bed sheets and mattress will be provided by the host school.
2. The participating schools are requested not to search/book for Hotel Accommodation for their stay. Kindly don't worry about stay and meals. Unlike other schools, the organizing school itself has made stay arrangement for all the teams in the Best Hotels available in Chunar.
3. Meals will be arranged by the school. The meal coupons may be collected by the team managers on their arrival on payment of Rs.350/-per head per day which includes both boarding and lodging charges. This intimation shall be given in the enclosed Proforma. Time schedule is given below.

Breakfast : 07.30 AM to 8.30 AM

Lunch: 12.15 PM to 1.45 PM

Snacks : 03.30 PM to 4.30 PM

Dinner : 07.30 PM to 9.00 PM

Above mentioned (breakfast, lunch, snacks and dinner) will be provided at the allotted place only and within the scheduled timings.

4. Outside food is not permitted due to hygienic reasons.
5. The main gate of the school will remain closed for the participants from 10.00 pm to 5.00 am. No one will be allowed to go out or come in side during this period.
6. Paid canteen facility will also be available in the campus.
7. Laundry facility will not be available in the school during the tournament.
8. **As per CBSE rules -** Where the championship is being held on league-cum-knock out basis, the organizing and participating schools may collect/deposit payments against meals together for all the days of championship and no part payment will be collected/deposited; or the participating schools will not insist for refund of part payment. The teams returning shall be eligible for refund of payment deposited, but only for the post 24 hours balance meal coupons.

Way to Reach The Venue

The school is located on Mirzapur – Varanasi (NH-7), Chunar in eastern Uttar Pradesh. Chunar is connected to Various Part of the country by Road & Railway. It is 40 Km away from Varanasi Railway station and 35 km from Mirzapur Railway station. Non AC Buses and Cabs are available from Varanasi to Chunar and from Mirzapur also. It's a 2:00 hour Journey from Varanasi to Chunar and from Mirzapur to Chunar also. At Varanasi Railway station, Mirzapur Railway station, **School bus will be available to pick and drop the teams to & fro by paying Rs.50/- per candidate**

Lal Bahadur Shastri International Airport Varanasi is the nearest airport (60 Km). Regular flight from Delhi, Mumbai, Kolkata, Bengaluru, Lucknow & Ahmedabad and International flight are available, **School bus will be available to pick and drop the teams to & fro by paying Rs. 100/- per candidate from Lal Bahadur Shastri International Airport Babatpur Varanasi.**

Note: We request you to inform us regarding your arrival plans well in advance so that transport arrangements from the Railway Station/ Airport could be made

DISCIPLINE

1. Each school will send one responsible staff member as the Manager with the team. He / she will be responsible for his / her team on and off the field and the Team Manager will be fully responsible to maintain discipline. In case of any indiscipline the team will be sent back at the same time. If girls are participating, a lady staff member should accompany them.
2. All the teams and their escorts / in-charge will be under the administrative control of the Principal, Chairman & Organizing Committee.
3. Any damage done at the venue of the stay or to the property of the school during the stay by participants will have to be compensated by the respective team manager / coach.
4. Consumption of tobacco, Liquor and non vegetarian meals is strictly prohibited during the conduct of the tournament and stay in the school. Our campus is smoke free zone. Anyone found guilty of consuming meat, liquor, tobacco and drugs will be immediately removed from the school campus.
5. Medical checkup will be mandatory in case of doubt for taking drugs or overage of players.
6. January is the month of severe cold in Chunar. All the players are advised to carry woolen clothes (sweater, Jacket or Blazer) for their comfort.
7. The decision taken by the jury in any dispute or appeal will be final and binding.

SECURITY DEPOSIT

An amount of Rs. 2000/- (Rs. Two thousand only) per school should be deposited at the time of registration on arrival of the team towards Security Deposit which will be refunded at the time of departure after making deductions, if any, for the damages done to school property by the team.

VOLLEYBALL **(Games Rules)**

1. The rules as adopted by the Volleyball Federation of India shall be followed, unless otherwise modified in these rules.
2. At Cluster level, all the matches shall be played on knock out basis.
3. The matches at Cluster level shall be played as best of three sets, each set of 25 points. A set is won by the team which first scores 25 points with a minimum lead of two points. In the case of a 24-24 tie, play is continued until a two point lead is achieved (26-24; 27-25;)
4. The semi-final and final, will be played as best of five sets. In case of a two – two sets tie, the deciding set (fifth set) will be played to 15 points until a two point lead is achieved (16-14; 17-15;)
5. Maximum two „time outs“ per set, of 30 seconds each will be allowed on the request of concerned coach/captain.
6. The colour and design of the playing kit of the members of team must be the same, except for ‘libero’ (defensive player) who must wear a uniform contrast in colour with that of the other members of the team.
7. The winning teams from every Cluster will qualify to participate in National level tournament.
8. At National level, matches shall be played on league cum knock out basis.
9. All the matches at National level will be played on the basis of best of five sets.
10. At National level: All the teams reporting may be divided into different pools in such a way that by and large, no pool is of less than four teams. From each pool, the two teams emerging on top will qualify to play the knock-out stage matches. The match to decide the third and fourth positions shall also be played.
11. In the matches played on league basis, in case of tie, the match will be decided as follows:

At first the following calculations will be taken –

Match won = 02 points. Match lost = 01 point. Match forfeited = 00 point.

Result will be tabled as under:

In case of a tie of total points at (D) between two or more teams, the following equation determines the ranking

$$\frac{\text{Sets Won (E)}}{\text{Sets Lost (F)}}$$

The team of higher rate of sets will be ranked higher. If the tie still persists, the following equation will be applied:

$$\frac{\text{Total score points in favour (G)}}{\text{Total score points against (H)}}$$

Team of higher rate of scored points will be ranked higher.

If the tie remains undecided, precedence will be given to the team winning the match in which the concerned teams have played against each other.

12. Ordinarily, no team shall be called upon to play two matches a day. In exceptional circumstances, however if a team is asked to play two matches a day, there should be at least a gap of four hours between the two matches.
13. A team shall consist of a maximum of 12 players.


